
PROGRAM GROWTH 2008-2010

2010-2011 Geographic Distribution of Scholarships




Characteristics of Successful Programs





The year 2010 is an electrifying time to pursue nursing. Between the passage of health care reform, Emmy success for *Nurse Jackie*, and the centennial of Florence Nightingale's death, nursing has definitely been in the public eye this year.

To honor the International Year of the Nurse, RWJF's senior adviser for nursing, Susan B. Hassmiller, Ph.D., R.N., F.A.A.N., spent her summer vacation in Europe, pursuing a dream to learn firsthand about the life and work of the legendary Florence Nightingale. In a series of blog posts detailing her special study tour to mark the 100th anniversary of Nightingale's death, Hassmiller reported on her trip, what she learned, and what it means to nurses' work today.
