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



Time: What You Can Do

- Realistically assess the amount of time mentoring will take
- Encourage participants to allot enough time for mentoring
- Support time for mentoring even when it competes with other time commitments
- Communicate clearly with supervisors regarding the time expectations for mentoring partners so they don't feel blindsided
- Making time management training available so that mentoring time is well spent
- Providing tools and guidelines to help keep mentoring conversations on track
